Other Requirements

- Students must earn a C or higher in all courses taken for the minor.
- All courses completed for the minor must be taken for a letter grade.
- All students must complete at least 15 credit hours toward the minor that are not counted in the student's major or specialization or another minor.
- For non-business students, the total number of hours earned in College of Business Administration courses may not exceed 25 percent or 30 hours of the 122 needed for graduation, counting the major and the minor. (Note: six hours of STAT and nine hours of ECON are exempt from this limitation).

Course substitutions for the minor must be approved by Entrepreneurship Academic Programs.

What if I don't have a prerequisite for a course?

Prerequisites for all courses must be met.
